Significant Hazards	Control measures taken to reduce risk	Residual risk rating	What further action required?
Slips, trips and falls due to uneven ground	Grass cut regularly Site rolled once a year with a heavy roller	MEDIUM	
Slips, trips and falls due to wet ground	Water tap turned off when not in use Water must not be run directly on to the ground	LOW	Plastic crating available to put down by shelter entrances if sites waterlogged
Gates & fences - splinters from wood Cuts from barbed wire	No climbing on gates and fences Users to keep out of boundary area Gates to be kept shut when not in use	MEDIUM	All fences and gates checked annually
Contamination of water supply	Portable toilets must not be emptied or washed out other than in the specifically designated compound by the entrance gate	LOW	Task should be undertaken by adults only Care to be exercised when handling chemicals
Reed bed filtering the waste water and sewage system run off	Fenced off with gate No entry unless part of a specifically designated work party Boots and gloves to be worn	MEDIUM	
Injury due to carrying heavy loads	Controlled by leaders Use trolley provided in each shelter	LOW
